We work with people who are requiring support due to many barriers including learning/physical disabilities, homelessness, drug and alcohol addictions, offending behaviour, mental health issues, care-leavers, lone parents and young people with additional support needs.

We facilitate a number of [workclubs](#) Highland wide offering motivation skills, literacy and numeracy, c.v building, job search, interview techniques etc.
