WHAT DOES JOINING DAY1 MEAN?

You will meet with your personal mentor weekly for twelve months and try out different activities (that you choose), and talk to them about anything you like.



WHAT IS A MENTOR?

Your mentor is someone that DAY1 will specifically match to you to offer you guidance. They are people that DAY1 has chosen because they are good listeners, approachable, totally independent of school or any other authority, and they want to help you find and achieve your dreams. Your mentor can help you think about jobs and college courses or placements. Your mentor will be matched to your personality and your interests. You and your mentor will swap phone numbers or email addresses and chat directly to each other.
