These include:

- advisory services
- services that focus on encouraging young people to take part in sport and healthy activities
- mentoring – one-to-one support for young people experiencing problems with drugs and alcohol
- intensive support and guidance to extremely vulnerable young people
- fostering services for children who cannot live with their birth families
- intensive community based group and one-to-one services for vulnerable adults

We have tailored these innovative services to help us to achieve our main aim: **To ensure the best outcomes for the children, families and communities across the North of Scotland.**

We work in partnership with many organisations and individuals in the Highlands including voluntary agencies, local authorities, churches, businesses, staff and people who use our services.
