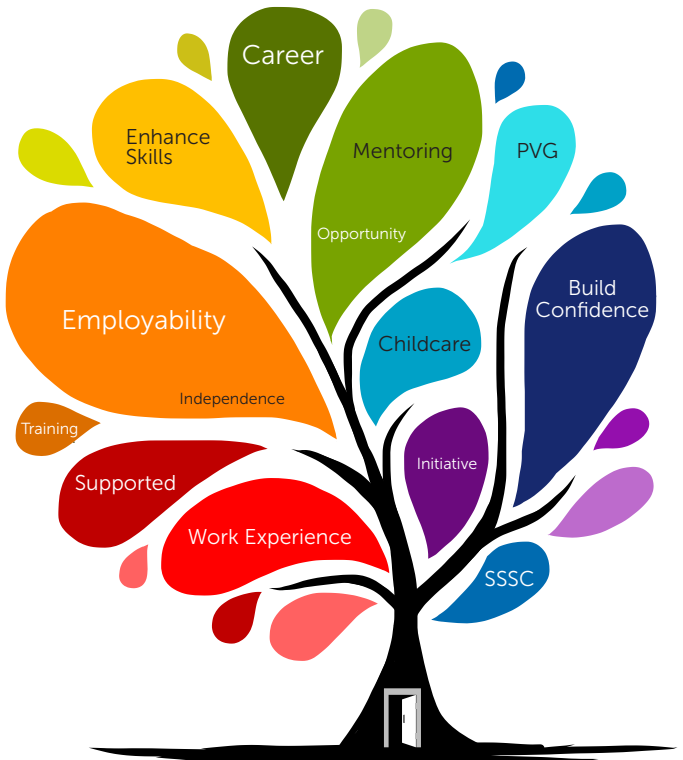


Interested In a career In childcare?

Where?

#Openingdoors is a flexible programme that delivers group learning days in the Inverness, Ross-Shire and Sutherland areas. However, there is the opportunity to work on a 1:1 basis if needed. Your Mentoring Support Officer can meet you wherever is easy for you - a local cafe, school, library or at home.

When

Group learning days are once a week for 6 weeks and your Mentoring Support Officer can meet at a time that suits you to help you prepare for this.

How much will it cost?

Taking part shouldn't cost you anything. All of your travel expenses will be paid during your time with #openingdoors

How long will it last?

It's up to you, you can go at your own pace. You will be supported for as long as you like, until you are in paid work or decide to leave the project.

What will I gain?

You get out what you put in at #Openingdoors. With our support you will gain confidence, knowledge and skills as you work through the programme. You will gain a completion certificate for each phase completed and a graduation prize of £50 when all phases are completed.

Are you 16-24? Does working in childcare interest you? Do you want to enhance your employability skills? Do you want to try a supported work experience placement?
